



Protector Tubing

IMPORTANT SAFETY CONSIDERATION

Protector Tubing is intended as a covering to protect against incidental wildlife contact with an energized wire or conductor and should not be considered as insulating protection against human contact.

Applying the Protector Tubing


STEP #1 Measure and cut the protector tube to desired length. Use a knife or scissors.



STEP #2 Open up one end of the Protector Tubing and wrap it around the conductor. Slide or wrap the remaining length of tubing on the line.



STEP #3 Completed application shown below.
